

WHAT IS FMEA?

FMEA is a not-for-profit professional association that serves and supports music educators across Florida. FMEA promotes and publishes the Florida Music Director as well as music education research, organizes in-service programs, and broadens teacher's knowledge and interest in their profession through affiliation with colleagues. Membership in FMEA is open to music instructors from Pre-K level through college, including music supervisors.

WHAT CAN I DO?
